



Log Cabin Quilt Workshop with Janet Houts

Fun, fast and perfect log cabin blocks with this new no-math, no-measuring method. Trimming each round after each fabric strip is sewn insures a perfectly pieced block with more sewing and less cutting.

Materials List

The Log Cabin Trim Tool designed by Jean Ann Wright (co-author of Log Cabin Quilts, the Basics and Beyond) is required for the class. The ruler can be purchased in advance from jeanannquilts.com or the day of class.

8" ruler: \$19.50

6-12" ruler: \$25.00

There are two sizes of ruler:

One ruler makes an 8-inch block, and the other ruler makes both a 6" and a 12" block.

Option #1: Choose a pattern and fabrics from the book for your project.

Option #2: Choose fabrics for your log cabin blocks and finalize the quilt design in class.

Yardage calculated for a total of 48 blocks

6" Finished Blocks	
(1) fat ¼ or ¼ yard each	6 light value fabrics and 6 dark value fabrics in different prints for logs
(1) fat ¼ or ¼ yard	contrasting fabric for center squares
8" Finished Blocks	
(1) fat ¼ or ¼ yard each	8 light value fabrics and 8 dark value fabrics in different prints for logs
(1) fat ¼ or ¼ yard	contrasting fabric for center squares
12" Finished Blocks	
(1) fat ¼ or ¼ yard each	16 light value fabrics and 16 dark value fabrics in different prints for logs
(2) fat ¼'s or ½ yard	contrasting fabric for center squares
