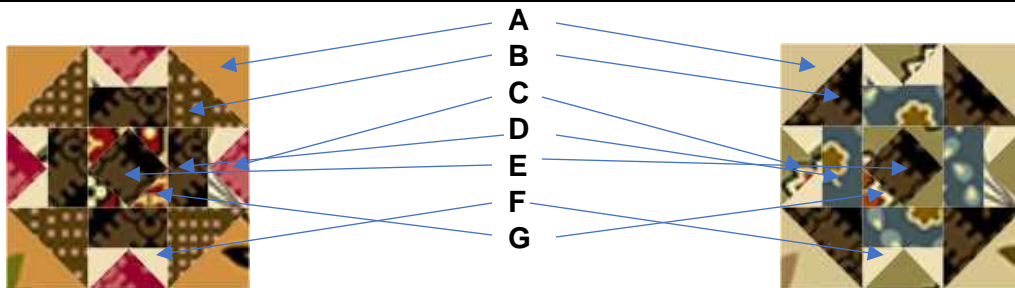

Krisanne Watkins for Quail Valley Quilts

Finished quilt size=70 inches by 87 inches

Fabric	Designation	Cut Size	How Many per block	Further Instructions
Background (cream or Gold print)	A	10 inch square	1 (Makes 2 blocks)	Draw twice diagonally on wrong side
Medium/Dark Print 1	B	10 inch square	1 (Makes 2 blocks)	Draw twice diagonally on wrong side
Medium/Dark Print #2	C	5 ¼ inch square	1	Geese
Medium/Dark Print #3	D	2 ½ by 4 ½ inch rectangle	4	
Dark Print	E	Scant 3 1/2 inch square	1	Center square
Light Print #2 (white)	F	2 7/8 inch square	4	Geese, draw diagonal line on wrong side
Medium Print	G	2 7/8 inches	2	Cut once diagonally
Setting				
Gold	Inner border	2 inch by WOF	8 strips	Piece together for length
Gold	Side Triangle enhancement	4 ½ inches	10	Draw diagonal line on wrong side
Floral	Side Triangles	18 ¼ inch square	3 (discard 2 triangles)	Cut twice diagonally
Floral	Corner Triangles	8 ½ inch squares	2	
Floral	Outside Borders	8 ½ inches by 76 inches	4

Make 12 blocks with light background

Because this quilt is “planned scrappy”, I did not list specific fabrics for B, C, D, and G. Notice in the cutting instructions that each is listed with size and number of shapes to cut for one block.

Choose four fabrics that vary in scale and color. My preference is to use a lot of contrast in color especially because it makes the block itself much more interesting.

Note that A and B are enough for two blocks. We will be doing a fast, easy way to make 8 half square triangles at once, so will use four in a block in class, and save the other four for another block.

If the "further instructions column information is confusing, wait until class and we will explain it better.

Completely ignore the rows below the setting in the cutting chart. We will also talk about that in class.

My intention is to bring some fabric to class, hopefully precut, so that, if you don't understand, you can just use the stuff I bring. So, no worries about anything if you don't get a chance to pre cut.

You only need to cut enough for 2-3 blocks plus the following:

---4 rectangles that measure 2 ½ inches by 4 ½ inches from a dark print.

---8 squares cut 2 ½ inches.
